1 Corinthians 12:4

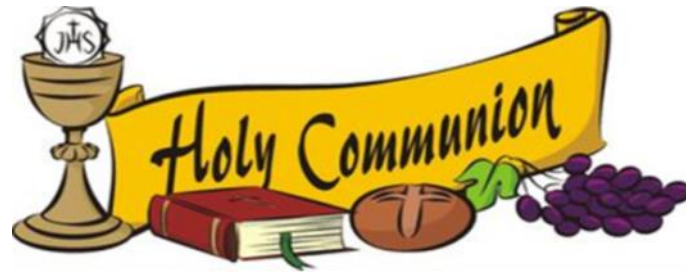
